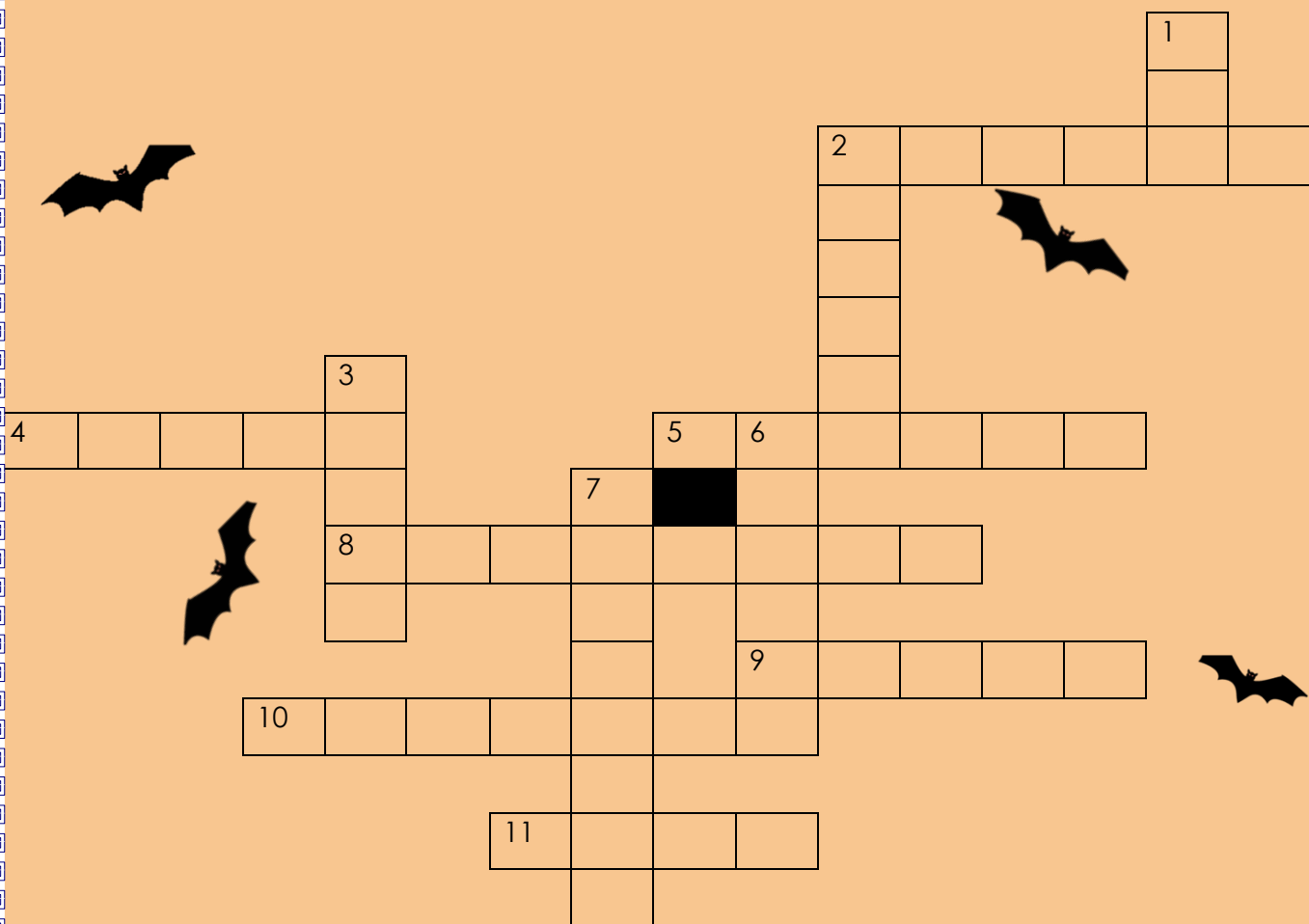


# Crossword puzzle

As laughter and screams fill the streets, oh what a rag!

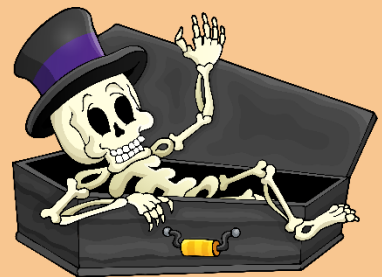
But remember, dear child, it's all just for fun,
